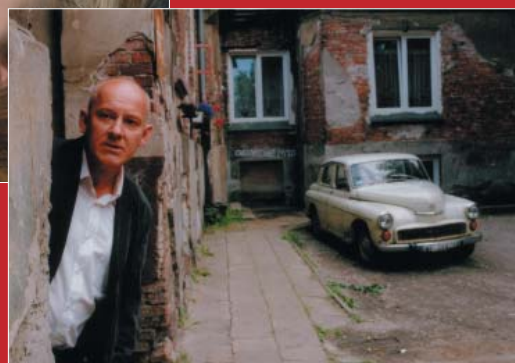
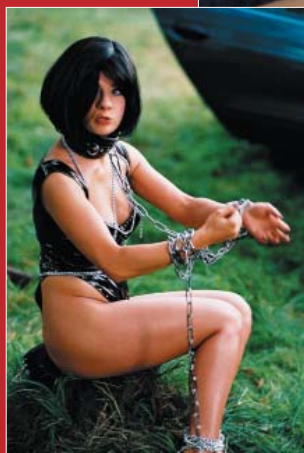
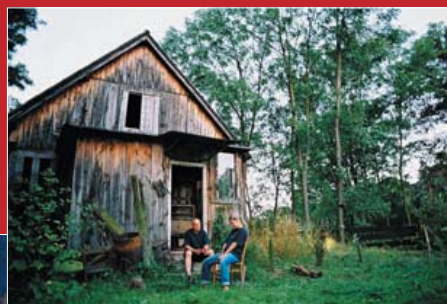

SYNOPSIS



It's been 20 years since Krister set foot in Poland and he's in for a number of big surprises...a modern Oedipal myth, a tale of voyeuristic obsession, INHERITANCE chronicles the transformation of a man in Warsaw as the city itself, emerging from its communist past, goes through its own changes.

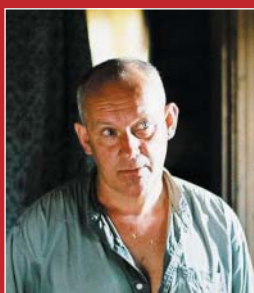
Krister, a middle-aged Swede of Polish origin, has been retreating from the rigours of the modern world. His life, on a small island near Stockholm, has turned into an uneventful slow death. His memories of Poland, a country he visited during his teenage years, are just as sad. The only reason he goes back is because he inherits a cottage in the Polish countryside. When he arrives in Warsaw, Krister is surprised by the city's modern infrastructure and by its outward signs of wealth. The butcher's shop he used to go to is now a sex shop, and his teenage friend Grzegorz is now a very respectable eye surgeon - and gay... Krister is in for an even bigger shock as he meets twenty-something Ewa. Krister thinks he is falling in love with her, which gives him a new zest for life. His discovery that she is a porn actress only adds to his obsession - until he learns that their meeting is no accident - she is his daughter.

The lead male role is played by the Swedish actor **Tomas Norström**, who gained international recognition with the award-winning *Kitchen Stories* (Golden Swan, Copenhagen International Film Festival; International Jury Award, Sao Paulo International Film Festival). The film has **grossed in excess of \$349,315** (June 2005; source: IMDB) **on the US box office**. It was also the Academy Award entry from Norway for best foreign film.



The lead female role is played by **Anna Powierza**, one of the most prominent young Polish actresses. Anna has featured in over 20 films, notably *Panna Nikt* by Wajda, and stars in the acclaimed Polish TV series *The Clan*, directed by Pawel Karpinski.



Also starring is **Krzysztof Kolberger**, one of the leading actors in Poland. A leading member of the National Theatre in Warsaw, he has appeared in many films, working such directors as Andrzej Wajda, Krzysztof Zanussi and Jan Lomnicki.

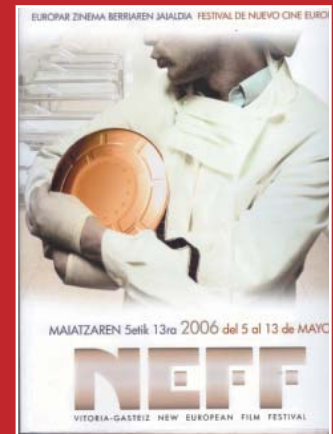
Directed and Producer by Edward Porembny
